ISRIC AND SOILSCAPES OF THE VELUWE

Two-day excursion to the International Soil Reference and Information Centre and to the periglacial soilscapes around Wageningen

June 2-3, 2014

This 2-day international excursion will pay a guided visit to the world-renowned ISRIC Soil Museum and to the spectacular periglacial soilscapes and riversystems of Wageningen and the Veluwe.

ISRIC - World Soil Information is an independent, science-based foundation. The institute was founded in 1966 following a recommendation of the International Soil Science Society (ISSS) and United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). It has a mandate to serve the international community with information about the world's soil resources to help addressing major global issues. ISRIC is the ICSU World Data Centre for Soils (WDC-Soils) since 1989 and it collaborates with a wide range of partners worldwide. ISRIC operates in three priority areas: soil data and soil mapping; application of soil data in global development issues; and training and education. Since 2011, ISRIC has worked on the construction of a new World Soil Museum located on the campus of Wageningen University and Research Centre (WUR). On 250 square meters it displays a selection of ISRIC's unique soil monolith collection. Further, visitors can experience the role of soils in supporting life and ecosystems, and get an impression of the enormous variation of soil types around the world, from the colorful volcanic ash soil from Indonesia to the man-made Terra Preta soil from the Amazon.

During the second day, the soilscapes surrounding Wageningen will be visited, which were formed by periglacial phenomena, rivers and anthropogenic factors, leading to a large variety in geomorphology, deposits and soils. We will start on top of the glacial end-moraine (Wageningse berg) and continue to the river- and valley systems (Gelderse Vallei). This valley comprises poorly drained sandy and clayey soils and lowland peat area's. In the afternoon we will visit the Veluwe with dry Podzol profiles and Plaggic Antrhosols on old agricultural fields (enkeerd- en laarpodzolgronden), and 'het Wekeromse Zand', a large area with shifting sands that originated from intensive use, which included the collection of plaggen. Deep Plaggic Anthrosols and buried Podzols further evidence the land-use history of this remarkable area.
